The above fees include transportation, textbooks, computer and technology fees, software, student activity fees, day trips, required service trips, one-day extra-curricular activities, instrument use for music class and band, lockers and locks and yearbooks.

Tuition is normally paid monthly beginning July 1 and ending June 1. Re-enrollment is assumed until graduation unless we are notified by on or before April 30.

As a registered charity, tuition payments beyond \$8,500 (approx) per student qualify for a donation receipt.

A. Long-Term Supporter Discount: Families qualify after four years of having a child or children enrolled at TDChristian **or** if they have donated at least \$4,000 to TDChristian by July 31 of the calendar year prior to their first child enrolling at TDChristian.

B. Children in Christian Primary Discount: Families qualify if they have a child or children enrolled in and are paying tuition to an approved Christian, primary, independent school.

Other Fees (if applicable):

1. A one-time **New to Christian Education Fee** of \$2,500 is charged to families who have never enrolled a child in an approved Christian, primary, independent school. The fee is reduced for families who have had a child enrolled in an approved school for one year (\$1,875), two years (\$1,250), or three years (\$625).

2. A volunteer assessment of \$1,000/year is charged to families who choose not to participate in the **Parent-Guardian Volunteer Hours Program**.

3. Fees, generally not to exceed \$85/day, can be charged for overnights trips associated with *optional* courses such as Grade 10 French, Grade 12 French, and Grade 12 Earth & Space Science, as well as *extracurricular* overnight sports tournaments, such as OFSAA and OCSSAA, and overnight music retreats or tours.
