## Program Goal

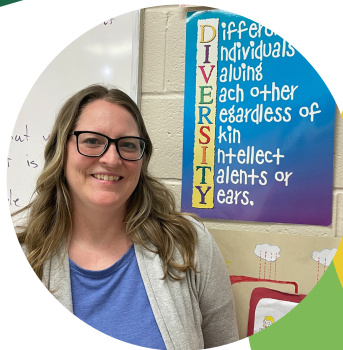
