



### **Student Statement of Commitment**

We are excited that you will become part of TDChristian High School. We look forward to working with you in your learning. In order to do so, we are asking you commit to the following:

1. I will work with TDChristian High School to realize its vision for assisting students to “learn for service in the light of God’s word” as every activity of the school is guided by Biblical principles.
2. I have read the Family & Student Handbook and understand its contents. I will work with TDChristian to realize its goals.
3. I agree to faithfully carry out my duties as a student (i.e. do my homework, cooperate and work with teachers, abide by school regulations as outlined in the Family & Student Handbook. Note: We call this “being onside”.)
4. I will refrain from using or being with someone who uses alcohol, tobacco, drugs or a vaporizer (e.g. e-cigarette) during the school day or in connection with any school-related activity as TDChristian forbids the use of such substances and items. 5. If I am a Grade 9 student, I will not leave school property from when I arrive in the morning to the time I leave at the conclusion of the school day, without written authorization by my parent/guardian and signed by the principal or designate.
