

Each year, TDChristian invests in safe, reliable, and welcoming transportation for our students. With costs amounting to approximately \$1.4M, this program ensures that families from across the Greater Toronto Area can send their children to TDChristian without the barrier of distance. For many families, access to school transportation is the deciding factor in choosing TDChristian, making it crucial for enrolment and the diverse, thriving community we cherish.

## GAME ON: HELPING OUR ATHLETES REACH THEIR POTENTIAL

At TDChristian, athletics is more than competition; it's an avenue for growth, Christian leadership, and belonging. Through sports, students develop discipline, teamwork, and resilience while building lifelong friendships. Rooted in three core values—Honour God in all you do, Respect others and the game, and Compete with all your heart—our athletics program encourages students to strive for excellence while reflecting Christ in their actions both on and off the field.

Each year, TDChristian offers students a wide range of athletic opportunities from basketball and volleyball to cross-country and soccer. The annual budget for the athletics program provides approximately \$400 per student-athlete. covering only a portion of the expenses for equipment, transportation, and tournament fees that are needed.

#### EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING: EXTENDING LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM WALLS

At TDChristian, we believe that education extends far beyond the classroom. Field trips provide students with hands-on, immersive experiences that deepen their understanding of creation, history, and culture. These trips align with putting faith into practice, offering students opportunities to explore, reflect, and grow expanding our classrooms to the neighbourhood and even the world through service trips to places like Belize.

One experiential learning opportunity we've established is the Grade 9 Geography trip to Crawford Lake, a global marker site for the Anthropocene epoch. This trip blends human and physical geography, offering a rich learning experience that stays with students long after they return to school. Here's how students reflected after the trip:

"I could really sense God's presence in this place."

"Enjoying nature, being with our friends, getting away from the traditional classroom... even for just one day was one of the best learning experiences I've ever had."

"The exhibits and experiences at Crawford Lake gave us a chance to see so many Indigenous innovations in action, like the turtle shell calendar, the four sacred plants, and a 600-year-old grinding stone!"

#### RAISING A JOYFUL SOUND

Music has long been an essential part of the educational experience at TDChristian High School. Through band, ensemble, and individual study, students grow their musical abilities while gleaning the cognitive and academic benefits from playing an instrument.

At TDChristian, students explore brass, woodwind, and percussion instruments primarily through a rental system. However, these costs have increased dramatically. The Music Department's desire is to purchase instruments instead of renting them, so we can ensure that students have access to high-quality instruments while freeing up more funds to improve other facets of our music program.

For students like Josiah Fraser, music has been life-changing:

"Music is truly important to me because it has many variables that can invoke meaning or emotions. Being able to actively play a clarinet and understand something I enjoy is not just educational, but eye-opening to see what makes good music." — Josiah Fraser

TDChristian will initiate the transition away from instrument rentals by purchasing 12 clarinets. Your donation will give our current and future clarinetists the opportunity to develop their musical skills on well-made instruments.

To continue inspiring and equipping our students, we need to upgrade our equipment. With the purchase of new mirrorless cameras and essential accessories, students will gain valuable skills in digital photography and editing, preparing them for careers in media, design, and even ministry.



"A new set of cameras would allow students to explore night sky and macro photography while also learning how to take professional headshots and product photos," explains teacher Joel Sjaarda.


## KRISTINA'S WISH: TAKE A SEAT AND WATCH OUR STUDENTS SHINE

#### NURTURING EVERY STUDENT'S WELL-BEING: BODY, MIND, AND SOUL

The pressures of academics, social dynamics, and the broader cultural climate can take a significant toll on a student's mental and emotional wellbeing. Our students face challenges from social media and the constraints and fallout of the pandemic that are different from those faced by previous generations, making it essential for them to have access to support.

Because we recognize that God cares about our whole person—body, mind, and spirit—TDChristian offers up to six no-cost psychotherapy sessions for students who seek it. These services provide students with a safe, confidential space on site to address their mental health concerns and develop strategies that will help them with their learning and other aspects of their lives.

Project 20/20, completed in November 2020, blessed the school with many improvements, including a spacious front foyer, a state-of-the-art Presentation Centre, a university-style classroom, and an innovative Learning Commons that enhances student learning. These upgrades have transformed the school environment, but the \$3.4 million mortgage remains a challenge.
