

Grade 9 Course Program

In Grade 9, you'll have an opportunity to learn across a breadth of subject areas. Students typically earn these eight credits towards their high school diploma in Grade 9:

- o **English**, ENL1W
- Mathematics, MTH1W
- o Science, SNC1W
- Exploring Canadian Geography, CGC1D
- Healthy Active Living Education (Physical Education), PPL10
- o Integrated Arts, ALC10
- Core French, FSF1D. Students who are French-exempt may enrol in Learning Strategies, GLS1O, instead of French.
- Technology and the Skilled Trades, TAS10 or Communications Technology (The Pulse), TGJ10. Students will learn details of these two technology courses in Grade 9 Orientation week, and they will have the opportunity to apply to The Pulse at that that time if they are interested in this course.

Students may also elect to take **Choir**, AMV1O, or **Band**, AMR1O in addition to the regular eight Grade 9 courses. Information about how to register for Choir or Band will be provided during Grade 9 Orientation Week.
