

PARENT-GUARDIAN VOLUNTEER HOUR PROGRAM, 2025-26

Rationale

TDChristian High School is a learning community with students from families from all over the Greater Toronto Area (GTA). Families send their children because they believe TDChristian is a place where their children belong – where they can learn for service in the light of God’s Word.

TDChristian is supported by a wide community of people – alumni, past families, churches, and other people who believe that Christian high school education is important for our local and global communities, as well as each student. Their contributions help lower tuition fees for all families who send their children to TDChristian.

Another way tuition is reduced is through the **Parent-Guardian Volunteer Hours Program** which requires families to volunteer 25 hours of time in a host of areas (see the list below) throughout the school and throughout the school year. Some families choose to opt out by paying a \$1,200 fee, either in a lump sum or by having it added to their tuition.

Besides helping with tuition, having parents and guardian in the school and involved in school activities enhances the TDChristian community. Staff and students see parents and guardians and they see us in action. With people coming from all over the GTA, getting together and working towards the same goals is good for us. We are better when we work together!

Opportunities

TDChristian offers many programs and there are many ways to contribute from home, at school, at the Fire Hall Thrift Store, or via a combination of these. Process

- Determine where and how you will volunteer. Reach out to the contact. When done your hours, ensure your hours are tracked using one of the following methods:
 - Signing a volunteer sheet provided by your supervisor.
 - Following the process outlined for the activity e.g., baking
 - Completing a Feedback Form (e.g., at meetings, Presentations Day)
 - Emailing the supervisor and volunteering@tdchristian.ca with what you have done. e.g., driving students, mentoring. The supervisor will have to confirm the hours by replying all.
- TDChristian will track the hours and the type of hours via our new system, Axiom. We plan to email the number of hours you have earned up to four times this year. Since it is a new program for TDChristian, look for more announcements in THE WEEK@TDChristian and/or by clicking the Volunteering icon on the Splash! Page. TIP: Track your hours on the Parent-Guardian Tracking sheet for your own records.
- During the first week of June 2026, we will send you a message indicating that you have completed your hours or, if you have not completed your 25 hours, an invoice for the outstanding amount.
- If you have any questions regarding your hours (NOT how many you have), email volunteering@tdchristian.ca.

Guidelines

- The volunteer year for 2025-26 will run from June 1 to May 31 (e.g., June 1, 2025 to May 31, 2026).
- All families (except TDChristian employees) are required to complete 25 hours. Single parents are required to do 12.5 hours.
- Hours completed in the volunteer year go towards the current school year and cannot be transferred to the following year as we wish to ensure there are enough volunteer hours available for all families. Volunteering for more than 25 hours is wonderful, especially for the many who do so to make TDChristian better for our students' learning and experiences. As God does, we appreciate cheerful givers!
- Hours cannot be transferred from one family to another.
- The aim is to have parents and guardians complete the volunteer hours. However, with prior arrangement and permission, adult children or relatives may complete hours (e.g., costumes for the play, Saturday clean up but NOT meeting hours).

TDChristian Volunteer Hours FAQ

Q. What are volunteer hours, and why is this an expectation at TDChristian?

A. TDChristian is supported by a wide community of people – alumni, past families, churches, and other people who believe that Christian high school education is important for our local and global communities, as well as each student. Their contributions help lower tuition fees for all families who send their children to TDChristian.

Q. How many volunteer hours are required per family?

A. Each family at TDChristian is asked to complete 25 or more hours/ year. Single parents are required to do 12.5 hours.

Q. What is the time frame for completing hours?

A. The volunteer year will run from June 1 to May 31 (e.g., June 1, 2025 to May 31, 2026).

Q. Can volunteer hours be completed at the Fire Hall Thrift Store?

A. Yes! Fire Hall Thrift is across the parking lot from TDChristian and it is a great way to get involved with the school in a fun, retail space!

Q. What are some ways to get involved volunteering at TDChristian?

A. There are a couple of places to find opportunities to volunteer here at TDChristian. The best place to start is by checking the Volunteer section on the Family and Student Splash page: <https://tdchristian.ca/splash/volunteer/>.

Also be sure to check our weekly newsletter called *The Week @ TDChristian*, as we often advertise opportunities there.

Q. What if fewer than 25 hours are completed?

A. You will be credited for the hours completed, and TDChristian will assess the remaining hours at a rate of \$48/ hour.

Q. Is it possible to opt out of volunteer hours?

A. Some families choose to opt out by paying the \$1,200 volunteer assessment fee.

Q. If I complete extra hours this year, can I carry over volunteer hours to next school year?

A. No. Hours completed in the school year go towards the current school year to ensure there are enough volunteer hours available for all families. If you are compelled to volunteer over 30 hours, that's wonderful, but please do so in the spirit of selfless giving.

Q. How do I submit my completed hours?

A. Determine where and how you will volunteer. Reach out to the contact. When done your hours, ensure your hours are tracked using one of the following methods:

- a. Signing a volunteer sheet provided by your supervisor.
- b. Following the process outlined for the activity e.g., baking
- c. Completing a Feedback Form (e.g., at meetings, Presentations Day)
- d. Emailing the supervisor and volunteering@tdchristian.ca with what you have done. e.g., driving students, mentoring. The supervisor will have to confirm your hours by replying all.

Q. How do I know how many hours I have completed?

A. TDChristian will track the hours and the type of hours via our new system, Axiom. We plan to email the number of hours you have earned up to four times this year. During the first week of June 2026, we will send you a message indicating that you have completed your hours or, if you have not completed your 25 hours, an invoice for the outstanding amount. We also recommend that you keep track of your own hours!

Q. Can I transfer my hours to another family if I have completed extra?

A. No, volunteer hours are non-transferable as our desire is for all families to be committed to the volunteer program to the best of their ability.
