Fees this year are \$310.00. **Goalies are free.** Make cheques payable to "TDChristian High School".

Notes on this season:

- Our league is **non-contact** and students of all skill levels can play! Teachers play too!
- Games are at 7am at Al Palladini Recreation Centre (Islington & Rutherford) and at 3pm at Woodbridge Memorial Arena (Islington & Hwy 7). We begin with a 3-game (mornings-only) pre-season to assist the organizers in player assessment. In-season team rosters are subject to change.
- The first pre-season game is Friday, October 10 at 7am at Al Palladini.
- The fee covers in-season games and the end-of-year tournament in Brampton.
- New: Players receive a jersey which they must return at end of season, or pay a \$20 replacement fee.
- Players are required to wear full equipment at all times, including a neck guard and a full visor or cage.
- There will either be three or four teams this year, depending on number of signups. If we end up with three teams, there will be morning games only. Teams will not play more than once per week (unless a game is re-scheduled due to a snow day or other).
- All information and updates are in the Edsby group "Intramural Hockey 2025-26".

^{*} Carpooling rules: Players are restricted to naming two other individuals with whom they wish to carpool. Teams will be formed honouring these carpools as much as possible. The reason for the limit is that in the past carpooling was abused in order to create stonger teams. This rule is necessary. We want balanced and competitive teams! Please do not create tangled carpooling knots. You should discuss this with the other players that you are naming as your carpool mates. For instance, Player A can't name Player B and C as carpool mates, and then have Player B name two other players (ie. Player D and Player E) as carpool mates.
